

Sanctions & Export-Control Clause

For inclusion in sales contracts and pro-forma invoices issued by Autorent Europe

Insert the following clause, unchanged, into every sales contract issued by Autorent Europe. A short-form version for pro-forma invoice footers is provided at the end.

Full clause — sales contracts

- 1. Compliance.** The Buyer shall comply with all applicable export-control and sanctions laws and regulations of the European Union, the United Nations, the United States and the United Kingdom ("Sanctions Laws").
- 2. No re-export to Russia / Belarus.** The Buyer shall not sell, export, re-export, transfer, supply or deliver the goods, directly or indirectly, to the Russian Federation or the Republic of Belarus, to any person located in or established in those countries, or for use therein.
- 3. No sanctioned destinations or persons.** The Buyer shall not make the goods available, directly or indirectly, to any country, territory, person or entity that is the target of Sanctions Laws, and represents that it is not itself such a person and is not owned or controlled, as to 50% or more, by any such person.
- 4. Cascade obligation.** Where the Buyer resells or transfers the goods, it shall impose obligations equivalent to clauses 2 and 3 in writing on each subsequent purchaser, including the obligation to pass such obligations further down the supply chain.
- 5. Information & verification.** The Buyer shall provide, on request, end-user and end-destination information and documentary proof of the final destination (import, customs, registration or transport documents), and shall co-operate with the Seller's due-diligence and KYC checks.
- 6. Consequences.** Breach of this clause is a material breach entitling the Seller to suspend or terminate performance with immediate effect, to withhold or void warranties, and to claim damages and any agreed penalties. The Seller may notify the competent authorities. Optional penalty: the Buyer shall pay a contractual penalty of [•]% of the invoice value of the affected goods per breach.
- 7. Survival.** This clause survives delivery, completion and termination of the contract.

Short form — pro-forma invoice footer

The Buyer undertakes not to sell, export or re-export the goods, directly or indirectly, to Russia or Belarus or to any sanctioned destination or person (EU / UN / US / UK), and to impose the same obligation on any onward purchaser. Breach voids warranties and entitles the Seller to terminate and claim damages.
